2. Broadhead's TULAK THE SENTINEL AT TAZIEFF – very impressive youngster at this stage, Overall very well balanced with low set hocks and good tail set. Moved and showed extremely well. Show lots of promise.

1. Kemp's ANDIZHAN BANJALUCAH TO SUPHAZ JW - Super head, long neck, very good shoulders and return of upper arm, well sprung rib cage and short broad loin, lots of substance, powerful quarters, moved well. Good honest dog.
2. Parker and Hitch's ZENDUSHKAS GLENMORANGIE – very similar to 1 in outline. Good head, long neck good shoulders and well sprung rib cage, well balanced quarters and good sweep from hip to hock.
3. Smith's ASHAHNI ANIQ AT JULAM

POST GRADUATE 3

1. Smith's ASHAHNI ANIQ AT JULAM – good head and expression, long reach of neck, well laid shoulder, good spring of rib, short loin. In excellent condition, looked good when stacked and moved well.
2. Rowell's ARAMAIC PLAY TO WIN AT ZHEBOOIE – Good head and expression, long reach of neck. well balanced front and rear quarters. Good spring of rib, short loin, well muscled in tip top condition.

1. Griffin's ASHAHNI AJMAL AT LAZAKHAN JW – Excellent head and expression, good reach of neck, well balanced quarters, good depth of chest, nice level topline and prominent hip bones, good falaway and low set tail. Showed to perfection. Res BD
2. Vowles' AZMARI BLACK DIAMOND - Quality dog with good head and expression, long reach of neck with nice level topline and good tail set. Evenly balanced quarters, with long sweep from hip to hock. Standing looked good, moved well.
3. Wilkinson's JAHADI EXUS

OPEN 2

1. Hughes' GEZENCOL ENRIQUE B masked red overall a well balanced dog. Good head and expression, nice reach of neck good depth of chest and well sprung rib cage. Powerful quarters front and read, in good muscular condition.
2. Mathews' ISTANI LOVE IS THE DRUG AT SHURMA – Elegant dog with pleasing head and good reach of neck. Level topline, well balanced quarters, nice deep chest, short broad loin and good tail set, very unfortunate to come up against 1st.
